Plymouth Notch Food Concession President Calvin Coolidge State Historic Site

- 1) There is no cost mentioned for the use of the Wilder House facilities. We would like to know if we will be responsible for utility payments or any other costs in order to take advantage of storage and use space in that building.

Answer: GMP electrical and waste disposal

- i. GMP: June-July 2022: \$30.00
- ii. GMP: June-July 2021: \$40.00
- iii. Able Waste: monthly \$240.00 for whole site

Arrangements can be made to reimburse SOV-VDHP \$50.00 a month to cover costs of utilities and waste.

- 2) Section 2.3 states that all recipes requiring cheese must use Plymouth Cheese. We have worked with Leo already on featuring a pesto grilled cheese panini featuring Plymouth cheese and would love to offer Plymouth cheese as an option for our regular grilled cheese, but we would also like to be able to offer those items with the regular cheese that we use since it creates a specific texture and flavor that can't be reproduced with Plymouth cheese.

Answer: Yes, this is acceptable. We recommend using Plymouth Cheese when able and available, but it is not a requirement. We prefer Vermont cheeses. If recipes require different cheeses, that is fine and understandable. When Vermont cheeses are used, please advertise that.

- 3) We would like some clarification on the application process. We understand that we need to complete the certificate of compliance, but some of the addenda don't seem to apply to us. Do we need to complete all of these regardless?
