Program Overview

Annual Summary of Activities for Program Year 2020 (7/1/2019-6/30/2020)

The Vermont Community Development Program (VCDP) administers funding from the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. Activities that support economic development and affordable housing continue to be VCDP's top priorities for funding. The VCDP assists communities on a competitive basis by providing financial and technical assistance to identify and address local needs in the areas of housing, economic development, public facilities, public services and handicapped accessibility modifications. The program is designed to predominantly benefit persons of low and moderate income. In addition, financial assistance is provided to communities with urgent needs, such as threats to health and safety and removal of slums and blighted properties.

2020 CDBG Program Accomplishments

The CDBG allocation for the last program year was \$6,920,250. This past year VCDP awarded nearly \$7 million to 29 projects, which leveraged over \$47 million dollars. The funds were awarded to housing, economic development, public facility and planning projects. A breakdown of awards made this year, by project types follows. Four previously funded projects were enhanced to continue their services or to ensure project completion due to increased project costs. Program income from previous grants, other returned funds from prior grants, and a forward commitment of next year's allocation made it possible to fund all the projects below.

Housing

The VCDP awarded eight and enhanced three grants to housing projects that totaled \$3,009,101 in CDBG funding and leveraged over \$31 million in local, private and other federal and state resources. This collaborative effort will create or preserve 200 units of affordable housing and makes a significant contribution in addressing the affordable housing crisis.

Planning Grants

Vermont communities are afforded opportunities to undertake community development planning through technical expertise and professional resources for one or more of the VCDP areas of eligibility – housing, economic development, public facilities and public services. The VCDP awarded five and enhanced three grants for planning projects totalling \$272,544 that were provided to communities throughout Vermont.

Public Facility and Service Grants

The VCDP awarded six and enhanced two public facility grants that totaled over \$1.4 Million and leveraged nearly \$2.3 million in other resources. The VCDP awarded four public service grants that totaled \$191,500 and leveraged nearly \$300,000 in onther resources. The following projects will help enhance their communities; build handicapped access to three municipally owned buildings, build supportive housing and services for the homeless, make housing counselling available to more families, create a childcare facility, and create a sober living facility for people suffering from addiction.
