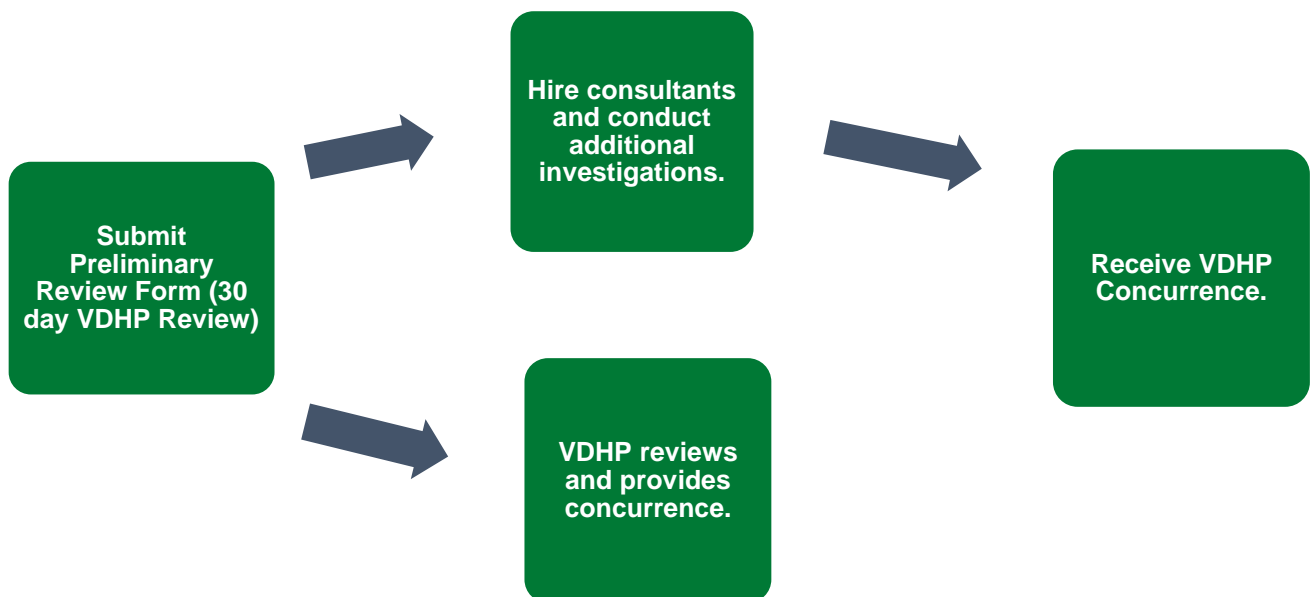




How do I start the Section 106 Review Process?

- To initiate the process, fill out and submit the [Section 106 Preliminary Review Form \(PRF\)](#). This form must be filled out to move forward.
- Provide a detailed project scope description in your PRF.
- Refer to Appendix A of the [Programmatic Agreement](#) to see Exempt Activities.
- The Vermont Division for Historic Preservation has a 30-day window to review and respond to the PRF submittal.
- If architectural or archaeological work is required, it can be time consuming and can be impacted by seasonal constraints.

What if my project needs a consultant?

Refer to VCDP's List of Approved Consultants.

- Reach out to multiple consultants for quotes. Clearly communicate the project's timeline.
- Provide your consultant with the Preliminary Review form that was completed by the VDHP.
- Reach out early to consultants. Share your project scope at the beginning of the project and as it develops/changes (if applicable).
- In the consultant's budget proposal, ask about including potential cost for Consultant Compliance Confirmation (CCC), if not already included.
