

## PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

## PROPOSED TIF DISTRICT & FINANCING PLAN - Revised

The Killington Selectboard will convene a public hearing on the proposed Town of Killington TIF District and Financing Plan on <u>Monday, May 2, 2022 at 7:30 p.m.</u> Pursuant to 24 VSA 1893. The hearing will be held at the Killington Public Safety Building at 800 Killington Road and via Zoom.

The Town of Killington intends to create a Tax Increment Financing district to provide incremental revenue for water and transportation infrastructure improvements that will stimulate commercial and residential development, create new affordable housing, address issues of transportation capacity and safety in the Town's core, and create economic prosperity in one of the State's most iconic ski towns, in keeping with the intent of 24 VSA 1893.
