Burying Yard Point

This site is the original cemetery for Isle La Motte, established by citizens at a town meeting in early 1792. Known as Burying Yard Point, this was the only town cemetery until 1813, and it contains the remains of American Revolutionary War patriots and Island settlers. In 1881, the burial ground was divided to allow for the construction of the bridge and the permanent road. All disturbed remains were reinterred elsewhere on this site. A stone monument was erected nearby and dedicated by the Isle La Motte Historical Society and the town in 1927 to honor the memory of the Revolutionary War Soldiers buried here. Hallowed ground remains on both sides of the road to this day.
