7. Description

The new location of the New Haven Junction Depot is a flat parcel of land 1.69 miles due east of its original location. The parcel fronts North Street, and the Depot now stands approximately 115' north of the New Haven Community Library & Town Offices. Placed perpendicular to the road and set back approximately 65' from the centerline, it is surrounded by mowed grass on the west, north, and east elevations, with a paved parking area on the south elevation. Originally oriented north-south, the Depot is now oriented east-west and was rotated 90° clockwise during the move.

Prior to relocation, the new site was evaluated for archaeological sensitivity and cleared. A new concrete block foundation with crawlspace was constructed, with the above-grade portion faced with granite-slab underpinning salvaged from the original building. The relocated Depot retains the same elevation above grade.

The relocation did not require any permanent physical exterior changes to the Depot. Two short brick chimneys, one at each gable end, were removed for the move. The brick was saved for reconstruction of the chimneys at the new location. The exterior signal mast that pierces the eave on the north elevation will be restored and reinstalled. The principal exterior materials of the property (stone foundation, brick walls, wood brackets, and slate roof) remain intact. The original arch-topped, double-hung wood windows and doors were removed prior to the move and will be reinstalled following rehabilitation. On the interior, original wood wainscoting and trim were removed prior to relocation and will be reinstalled.

8. Significance

The date of construction of the New Haven Junction Depot is 1868, based on the following article:

NEW DEPOT. – A commodious new brick depot is in process of construction on the east side of the road at the present New Haven depot, on the Rutland and Burlington railroad. The present depot is on the west side.¹


