I. Introductions, Announcements, and Public Comment

- Megan Albert has been contracted to assist 250th Commission. Will be attending Friday's Commission meeting.
- Stephen met with Senator Welch's office this morning to discuss 250th.

III. Update on Vermont 250th Anniversary Planning Grants – Steve Perkins

- Second round of planning grants occurred, opened it up to whole state.
- 13 approved, 3-4 sent back to revise and resubmit. At minimum, there will be 25 grants awarded. The next deadline will be in July.
- Eileen will send a PR to the local historical societies/libraries/community
 groups with examples of funded planning efforts. The website shows the
 original eight: https://vermonthistory.org/250th-grants. John will approach
 Vermont Covered for additional funds for planning grants and we will work
 to get implementation grants funded.
- Goal is to get another 25 applicants before July deadline.

IV. Next Steps for Administration and Finance Committee – All

- Megan can compile grant programs and funding opportunities at federal and state level. She will also be working on the 250th Website, attending America 250th conference in D.C.
- The national 250th anniversary commission is meeting on May 10, 2025, meeting at Fort Ticonderoga.
- Laura has only received one combined ask from Research & Historical and Arts & Culture – a \$500,000 ask for implementation grants and

staffing. Note: We will discuss the committees' requests at the next meeting. State funds could go through the Vermont Arts Council, Historical Society, and Humanities Council. Laura will send the "asks" to the A&F Committee shortly.

- Research & Historical also put together request for roadside historic markers that goes over the \$25,000 budget.
- Committee will review requests, send out another email about getting proposals for FY26 from remaining committees.
