Professional Qualifications Standards

The following requirements are those used by the National Park Service and have been previously published in the Code of Federal Regulations, 36 CFR Part 61. The qualifications define minimum education and experience required to perform identification, evaluation, registration, and treatment activities. In some cases, additional areas or levels of expertise may be needed, depending on the complexity of the task and the nature of the historic properties involved.

HISTORIAN REQUIREMENTS

The minimum professional qualifications in history are a graduate degree in history or closely related field; or a bachelor's degree in history or closely related field and a minimum of two years' experience.

*The minimum professional qualifications in historic architecture area professional degree in architecture or a State license to practice architecture, **plus one of the following:***

OR

- ☐ At least one year of full-time professional experience on historic preservation projects.

Such study or experience shall include detailed investigations of historic structures, preparation of historic structures research reports, and preparation of plans and specifications for preservation projects.
