CREATING AN ACCOUNT FOR THE BEGAP PROGRAM

Here is what to expect when creating an account with the State of Vermont to apply for a BEGAP grant. Below is a series of screen shots outlining the 9-step process.

You will need to register your email address, create a password, and submit a phone number. During the process you will receive two codes for multi-step authentication – one via email, the other via phone (text or call).

Also, have your documentation ready prior to starting your application. <u>Here is a list of what you need</u>. Please keep in mind, the system will not accept documents created in Word (.doc or .docx). You will need to upload documents in one of the following formats: .pdf, .png, .jpg

STEP 1: <u>Go to this web site</u>. Below is the screen you will see. Select "Vermonter Login" to create your account.



STEP 2: Create an account by clicking on "Sign up now" at the bottom of the screen below the big, blue "Sign in" button.
