- 1. Dismantle the remains of the former modern dining room entry cut into the original building.
- 2. Rebuild an original large fixed sash from the Inn as a double glazed window with sidelights.
- 3. Frame the dismantled wall opening in the fashion of the CPH's framing, placing the rebuilt window at the center.
- 4. Exterior sheathing and radially sawn spruce clapboard up to 16 ft. of height x 17 ft. long. Duplicate the baseboard, pilasters and plinths in place on adjoining corners of the CPH. Wood lath for plaster on the inside. Insulation in the wall cavities.

5. Interior trim and moldings to match those original to this portion of the CPH:
