The Town of Monkton is looking to replace and resize the Tyler Bridge Road/Pond Brook Culvert and is applying for a VTrans Municipal Highway and Stormwater Mitigation Program Grant to assist in funding the project. The existing culvert is a continuing maintenance issue and does not meet current VTrans Hydraulic Manual requirements for flow capacity. Also, it does not comply with State Stream Alteration Standards for aquatic organism passage.

- Report prepared by Shane Lawrence, Town Road Foreman, describing Existing Conditions of the Culvert and Work Performed including photos of pipe.
- VTrans Hydraulic Memorandum identifying recommendations and design parameters for a replacement culvert.
- Otter Creek Engineers Project Scoping, Early Concepts and Estimates Report.
- Zapapa Courage wetlands desktop review for planning purposes.
- Total Project Cost Estimate.
- Addison County Regional Planning Commission letter of support.

At its November 14, 2023 regular meeting the Selectboard showed its support by unanimously voting to apply for a Municipal Highway and Stormwater Mitigation Grant for the Tyler Bridge Road Culvert and discussing methods to fund the project local share.
