



To Whom it May Concern,

The City of South Burlington Stormwater Utility has been working to continue improvements to the stormwater treatment and drainage in the Potash Brook watershed for several years. A component of this work is to implement various stormwater treatment practices throughout the watershed that were proposed in the Potash Brook Flow Restoration Plan. One of these projects includes retrofitting an existing wet pond located at 43 Comcast Way into a gravel wetland. On 12/4, 2023 the South Burlington City Council voted to support the Stormwater Utility's plan to hire a consultant to perform a scoping study for this project. In addition, City Council supports the Stormwater Utility's grant application to the VTrans Transportation Alternatives Program. We authorize our Stormwater Superintendent, Marisa Rorabaugh, to act as the City's authorized representative when dealing with matters related to this study and the associated applications.
