SPECIAL CONDITIONS - DRIVEWAYS

1. The drive and proposed service road shall be constructed in accordance with the attached plans dated February, '76 and the profile and notes of Standard Drawing B-71, copy attached, Station 82+00 left of Project MA 3280. This to include, at Petitioner's cost, the frontage road and storm drainage system as shown on attached plan dated July, '76, constructed to State specifications and to the satisfaction of the District Highway Engineer.
2. The Petitioner agrees to allow highway storm drainage to enter the proposed storm drainage system and that the State shall be exempt from participating in the maintenance of the proposed system.
3. The drive must be constructed with a 9" depression in profile, to prevent water from running onto the highway. If requested, the District Highway Engineer will inspect the drive prior to paving. If this is not done, and the drive is not satisfactory, the District Engineer will order reconstruction of the drive by the Owner.
4. The Owner is responsible for driveway maintenance.
5. Curbing or other suitable physical barrier must be installed to prevent vehicles from parking on or crossing the highway right-of-way between authorized drives.
6. Construction of the drive, frontage road water and sewer lines will be performed in such a way that interference with traffic using the highway is kept to a minimum. If considered necessary by the District Highway Engineer, uniformed special officers shall be employed to direct traffic during the construction period, at the expense of the Owner.
7. Water and sewer lines shall be installed in accordance with Standard Drawing D-20.
