Dear Mr. Keller,

The town of Wallingford would like to install a solar flashing radar speed sign on Route 140E (School Street) on an existing 25 mph street sign.


The location of the sign would be about 2/10 of a mile east of Wallingford Elementary School on the north side of Route 140. Motorists traveling in a westerly direction toward the school tend to speed as it is downhill and they rush to make the green light at the bottom of the street.

Traffic moving in an easterly direction past the school comes from the Route 140 and 7 intersection and has either been delayed by the red light or by turning the corner onto Route 140, therefore speeding is not much of an issue from that direction.

Enclosed please find the speed survey, TA 210 permit form, sketch of the sign area, and technical information regarding the sign to be installed.

NOTICE OF AMENDMENT OF REVISED ORDINANCES OF WALLINGFORD
TITLE 2: TOWN HIGHWAYS

On April 17, 2017, the Selectboard of the Town of Wallingford, Vermont, adopted amendments to the existing Revised Ordinances of Wallingford, Title 2: Town Highways. This notice is published pursuant to 24 V.S.A. § 1972 to inform the public of these amendments and of the citizens' right to petition for a vote to disapprove these amendments.

FULL TEXT OF AMENDMENT

US Route 140E. A maximum speed of 25-mph beginning at the Junction of US Route 7 and extending easterly 0.30 miles to 0.10 miles east of TH-74 (mp 0.30) and from the point 35-mph easterly 0.30 miles to 0.40 miles east of TH-74 (mp 0.60) and from this point 40-mph extending easterly 3.73 miles to the intersection of TH-21 (mp 4.33). A maximum speed limit of 30-mph beginning at a point .16 miles west of TH-84 (mp 5.89) and extending easterly 0.45 to the Mount Holly town line (mp 6.34).

The full text of the Ordinance may be examined at Wallingford Town Hall, 75 School Street, Wallingford, Vermont 05773 during regular office hours.

Title 24 V.S.A. §1973 grants citizens the right to petition for a vote at a special or annual Town Meeting to disapprove ordinance amendments adopted by the Selectboard. To exercise this right, citizens must present to the Selectboard or Town Clerk a petition for a vote on the question of disapproving the amendments signed by not less than five percent (5%) of the Town's qualified voters. The petition must be presented within forty-four (44) days following the date of the adoption of the amendments. Unless a petition requesting a vote is filed pursuant to 24 V.S.A. § 1973, the amended Revised Ordinances of Wallingford, Title 2: Town Highways shall become effective sixty (60) days from the date of said adoption.
