In reference to the 2019 Railroad Rights-of-Way Vegetation Control Programs, listed below is the railroad formulations we are recommending for this years' application.

<b>Railroads</b>	<b>Formulations –First Application</b>	<b>Second Application</b>
1. <u>Pan Am Southern Railways</u>	1	2
2. <u>Green Mountain Railroad</u>	1	2
3. <u>Vermont Railway</u>	1	2
4. <u>Claredon &amp; Pittsford Railroad</u>	1	2
5. <u>Washington County Railroad</u>	1	2
6. <u>Washington County Ct. River Line RR</u>	1	2
7. <u>Central Maine &amp; Quebec Railroad</u>	1	2

**Formulations:**

1. 3.3 ounces Opensight plus 4 ounces Esplanade 200SC plus 1 quart Aquaneat plus 4 ounces Spyder
2. 2 quarts Aquaneat

All the formulations listed above will have a drift control agent added to the mixes to reduce chance of drift to non-target areas and a Surfactant or Spreader/Sticker if growth is present at the time of treatment in 30-40 gallons of water per acre.

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Enclosed are the Labels and Material Safety Data Sheets for Opensight, Esplanade 200SC, Aquaneat, and Spyder.
