
How to Sign Up to Receive Email or Text Notification of Right-of-Way Herbicide Use Through VT-ALERT

VT-ALERT is a Vermont-wide electronic notification system used to send messages via email, text, and posts to the website about emergencies and general public notices. You can start receiving notification of planned herbicide applications to utility, railroad, and highway Rights-of-Way by enrolling in VT-ALERT following these instructions.


- 1. Use your web browser to navigate to the VT-ALERT site at https://www.vtalert.gov/
- 2. Click "Enroll."
- 3. Create an account and set your contact preferences according to the instructions on the site.
- 4. Set your Alert Location(s)
- 5. <u>Set a CUSTOM WARNING SET</u>. ***Note, in order to receive notification of Right-of-Way herbicide use, you must create THIS CUSTOM WARNING SET:
 - a. On your account page, click "ADD SET +" under Custom Warning Sets.




b. Name it "ROW notification."



c. Under Categories, click the "Environmental" checkbox.



d. Under Sub-Category, click the checkbox for "Other Un-Categorized Environmental Event."



e. Click the SAVE button at the very bottom, and you are done.



You will now receive a notification via VT-ALERT when the Herbicide Use Permits for utility, railroad or highway rights-of-way are initiated. More specific information relating to the actual timing of herbicide applications in a given area is not available.
