What is the EBSG?

The Vermont's Environmental Justice Law from 2022 requires the Agency to develop guidance to help designated Vermont state agencies to report on the investments that support communities, especially those most affected by environmental issues.

Who is the EBSG for?

The EBSG is mainly for state agencies that need to follow the VT EJ Law, however, the law requires a public comment period. The EBSG is also a resource for anyone interested in how environmental benefits are reported.
