Working closely with the Climate Council office to ensure compliance and coordination with the Climate Action Plan. Explained the FEMA funding under declared emergencies to implement projects. Outlined FEMA's Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) program, best source of funding for statewide scoping and planning activities.
