



- 2. Encourage smart growth and related strategies
- 3. Achieve long-term sequestration and storage of carbon
- 4. Achieve net zero emissions by 2050 across all sectors
- 5. Reduce energy burdens for rural and marginalized communities
- 6. Limit the use of chemicals, substances, or products that contribute to climate change
- 7. Build and encourage climate adaptation and resilience




## **Guiding Principles for a Just Transition**


















2025 Plan Priorities: Subcommittee Schedule

#### Stage 1: April-June 2024 – Grounding, getting started

 Initial identification of high-level gaps and priority areas to update

#### Stage 2: July-Sept 2024 – Deliberation


- Review key scientific and other inputs
