These resources are for writing but are nonetheless very useful for speaking in a more understandable and accessible way.

- How to check readability in Microsoft Word (if the score isn't showing up for you, do this).
 View readability score and understand what it means. This does not show you how to improve readability though—see resources below.
- <u>Hemingway Readability Checker</u>. This interactive tool helps you test out other ways of writing or saying something that improves readability/accessibility.
- Plain Language Checklist. Helpful and quick resource that covers the basics.
- Federal Plain Language Guidelines. The lefthand menu provides helpful pointers, and the full guide is available for download.
- <u>Plain Language Basics Workshop recording</u>. While the workshop is long, it is possible to listen on 1.5-2x speed and skip over the group exercises.
