#### **Calculation of Homestead Tax Rate**

A rate is calculated for each budget and pro-rated, based on the number of equalized pupils that belong to each district (Local & Union) from the municipality. The pro-rated tax rates are divided by the CLA and summed to determine the municipality's homestead education tax rate. (Line 10)
