Archaeology Statistics 2012:

2012 Section 106 Programmed Project clearances*
total for year = 165

*This number represents programmed projects that were cleared, not the total number reviewed this year. This number does not include projects from the Town Highway Structures Program (THSP) or Waste/Borrow and Staging (WBS) reviews.

Archaeological Resources Reviews breakdown:

146	cleared after resource ID with no conditions
8	cleared after resource ID with conditions
6	cleared after Phase 1
3	cleared after Phase 2
2	projects went to Phase 3 mitigation (Addison-Crown Point and Royalton BRS 0147(13). Phase 3 for Royalton was completed in 2010 but the HP signoff was in 2012 so this one is showing a 106 completion date of 2012.

Of the projects cleared for archaeology in 2012, 59 required a field review ranging from a resource ID to archaeological testing and 106 were cleared after

a desk review. 34 projects cleared in 2012 were Irene related.

**Swanton is not included in the totals for 2013 because the Section 106 letter was not completed in 2013 but the project is worth mentioning here because the MOA was completed in 2013.

Of the projects cleared in 2013, 114 required field visits. 25 projects cleared in 2013 were Irene related.

Town Highway Structures Program (THSP) Totals:

2012 – Total = 151, Rejected = 0
2013 – Total = 148, Rejected = 1

Waste/Borrow & Staging Totals for 2012:

Total = 145
16 of those were rejected for either archaeological or natural resource issues. 5 were withdrawn after submittal.
The remaining were cleared or cleared with conditions.

Waste/Borrow & Staging Totals for 2013:

149 sites submitted
17 of those sites were rejected for either archaeological sensitivity or natural resource issues.
4 of the sites were withdrawn after submittal and the sites were not used.

Observations on Statistics:

2013 has seen a 60% increase in project clearances from 2012 with a total of 244 project clearances for Section 106. This is also much higher than the past 5 year average of 154. We are unsure at this time what is responsible for the drastic increase in projects. We are still encountering several post-Irene related projects which may account for some of the increased volume but we have also seen an increase in project submittals from all divisions over the past year as well as numerous reviews for scope changes.

Addison-Crown Point Restoration Phase: We encountered some challenges with regard to the plans and additional proposed ground disturbance that what was originally agreed upon. After a series of meetings and design revisions, all parties agreed to a minimized design in the areas of the amphitheater, overflow parking and pier path.

Monitoring by UVM CAP throughout the remainder of the restoration and further archaeological work as needed ensured that the archaeological concerns were being addressed and remedied immediately. This also allowed the project to keep moving forward. UVM CAP continued to work on the restoration phase throughout 2012 and 2013. The work was completed in the early summer of 2013 and impacts minimized or plans altered to avoid significant archaeological resources. Those that could not be avoided were mitigated.

An area close to the shore beneath the bridge containing significant rock carvings was impacted by the contractor during construction. A mitigation plan was agreed upon that included documentation and a LiDAR scan of the rocks. This work was completed by UVM CAP during the summer of 2013.

Swanton Route 78 Roadway Project: Phase 3 mitigation was undertaken after extensive interagency coordination. An MOA was executed among DHP, VTrans and the USF&WS. This was necessary as the USF&WS are not parties to the PA. An Adverse Effect letter was issued early in 2014 for FHWA per our PA as FHWA declined to participate in the MOA. Details of this project are provided below under "Highlights of the Year".

During both 2012 and 2013 all THSP programs were formally reviewed by 106 staff for archaeological and historic resources. These projects are not

included in the programmed projects so they are not shown in the statistics table for Section 106.

Off-site activities continued to be reviewed during 2012 and 2013. These included all waste, borrow and staging areas, dewatering areas, sediment control and other related activities.

A number of Irene-related projects are still coming through for review for permanent replacements or repairs.

A checkbox was added to the archaeology database to account for whether or not a project was the result of Irene. This allows us to track data pertaining to the amount of Irene-related project clearances that we are still encountering.

Highlights of the Year (2012 and 2013)

Swanton Route 78 Roadway Project: Phase 3 mitigation was undertaken after extensive

discussions with VTrans, DHP and NE Archaeology Director. A formal mitigation plan was prepared and agreed upon and submitted to the Dept. of US Fish & Wildlife for their approval. In addition, an MOA as requested by USFWS was submitted by VTrans due to the fact that a portion of the project passed through federal lands and our PA was not recognized by this party. However, an AE-SMM letter was still required by FHWA to comply with our PA. An ARPA permit was obtained and work began in late June. Coordination was also undertaken with the Abenaki in Swanton. Tribal members were involved in the fieldwork throughout the field season and they took part in an Open House Weekend on site in September for Vermont Archaeology Month. Fieldwork progressed throughout the summer and ended in October, 2013. Extensive coordination took place among all agencies and much of the public as well to make this project a success. Hundreds of folks visited the site including VTrans staff, DHP staff, school groups and members of the public at large.

VTrans Facebook postings: Brennan Gauthier has been assisting Giovanna Peebles (State Archaeologist) and Erik Filkorn (VTrans PR and Communications Specialist) with regular Facebook postings on archaeological and other transportation topics of interest to increase statewide awareness of the subject.

Increased use of digital mapping techniques (geodatabase referencing): Jen and Brennan have been learning and incorporating digital mapping techniques to improve documentation accuracy in project reviews. We are now able to record archaeologically sensitive areas into our geodatabase for use in ArcMap during project reviews and for project planning to incorporate accurately the sensitive areas on plans.

iPads were purchased and acquired by the section for use in field mapping techniques. We will be continuing to train and incorporate the use of this technology into 2014.

Brennan has been accessing Vermont State Archives and Records Administration (VSARA) and VTrans photographic collections in order to better understand the changing face of Vermont’s social and physical landscape over the past 120 years. He scanned, edited and printed over 40 large –size posters for the 2013 AASHTO conference held in Burlington and has worked closely with the VTrans public relations office to provide images of interest

for news outlets, police detectives, and historical societies.

Staff Achievements and Professional Development:

The VTrans Archaeology Officer was elected as a member of the Transportation Research Board (TRB) *Committee on Archaeology and Historic Preservation in Transportation (ADC-50)*. This is her second year serving on the committee.


She was also elected Chair of the *TRB Research Needs Subcommittee* and is currently serving as a member of a review panel for *NCHRP Task 88: Transferring Ownership of Historic Bridges: Approaches and Challenges*. Each research panel consists of a small group of elected professionals from transportation Agencies, private organizations, Federal Highway Administration and Advisory Council officials. This group reviews research topics, develops an RFP and manages consultant research projects on a topic that results in findings that can be used nationally to improve the field of Archaeology and Historic Preservation in Transportation.

Brennan has been obtaining GIS training to increase his knowledge of digital mapping and document storage techniques and working closely with the Mapping Section to incorporate the use of various mapping tools into our resource reviews.

Brennan has taken a number of web-based courses related to cultural resource management practices during emergency situations. FEMA courses include Social Media in Emergency Management, Coordinating Environmental and Historic Preservation Compliance, Effective Communication, Building Partnerships with Tribal Governments, ICS 100 and ICS 200 as well as FHWA provided courses in Cultural and Historic Preservation and Introduction to NEPA and Transportation Decision Making.

Innovative Programs:

Lidar Techniques: Brennan has been working with the mapping section to obtain the LiDAR maps for use in archaeological resource identification and documentation. We have also been coordinating with UVM and other agencies and organizations to test LiDAR techniques on archaeological sites. This is a useful technique as it is non-invasive for recording fragile material and recreating accurate images. This method was used by UVM on the rock carvings at Chimney Point. It is also useful as it removes vegetation from the equation which allows the ground features to become visible and easily detected.


VAI database updates: received federal funding to work on updating and improving the DHP electronic VAI database for shared use and uploading of site information.

Stone Culvert Survey: Brennan applied for and was awarded federal dollars to conduct a statewide stone culvert inventory. He had conducted similar work in New Hampshire and was inspired to apply for the federal program money to conduct an inventory in Vermont after a project was proposed that consisted of replacing an historic stone culvert constructed in 1899. Carvings on the lintel stone that included the date and initials of the roadway crew individuals added to the significance of this

structure. The majority of the inventory will be conducted and findings synthesized by a consultant however, students have participated in the survey as part of their class studies. Last fall three Historic Preservation graduate students from UVM assisted with this project and conducted an inventory in a few towns in central Vermont as their final class project. Their work will be incorporated into the larger inventory report.

Public Outreach/Education:

We are researching ways of incorporating the use of interactive methods into public outreach. Some of these methods include embedding video and documents into posters or pamphlets that include a QR code. Smart phones can be used on these locations to open up the embedded files. This allows even more information to be provided than what fits on a static space. Other types of interactive education involve the use of social media such as Facebook and Twitter to blog about current events in archaeology including our dig in Swanton.

We have also been using collections from past projects that may not be of exhibit quality but do

have incredible educational value. One such exhibit is the Ozias Atherton Historic Site in Waterbury, VT. This collection has been used extensively as an education tool in schools and presentations. We are planning to look at other collections that may have value for educational purposes including student research.

Two Community Based Learning (CBL) students from Montpelier High School worked with the VTrans Archaeology staff during the 2012 season. The program provides an opportunity for high school students to work alongside a professional and experience what it might be like to work in a career in their field of interest. They must complete a certain number of hours with the professional and write a report about their experience at the end of their term.

We are working with Giovanna Peebles (State Archaeologist) and area educators to find the best way to incorporate archaeology studies into school curriculums. Several meetings have been conducted thus far at the archaeology center.

Jen and Brennan have been asked to talk to students at various schools over the past year and share our experiences as Archaeologists. This includes working with the UVM Historic Preservation Program and presenting archaeology to the class each spring.

Vermont Archaeology Month (VAM):

2012 marked a change in the coordination and management of Vermont Archaeology Month. After several discussions involving the VTrans Archaeology Officer, State Archaeologist, the Vermont Archaeological Society PR staff-person and staff at the Department of Economic Housing and Community Development (DEHCD), VTrans and the State Archaeologist collectively made the decision to overhaul and redefine the program with assistance from staff at the DEHCD. VTrans entered into an MOU with the DEHCD and partnered with DHP to coordinate Vermont Archaeology Month rather than sole source to an outside organization. We created a list of goals that focused on ways to increase attendance, partners and participants, and expanded the use of social media including Facebook and other outlets to increase public awareness. VAM 2012 and 2013 were successful and DHP will continue to coordinate VAM in 2014. A VAM Summary Report was written and submitted to VTrans by the VAM Coordinator. That report provides greater detailed information regarding VAM and a summary of the events held.

Archaeology Heritage Center:

Federal funds were awarded for 2012 and 2013 as efforts were needed in organizing the collections at the newly developed heritage center.

An intern was hired to manage the collections that came over from the old facility. She also ensured that the inventory database was completed as new collections arrived.

The new space at the Vermont Historical Society contains two artifact storage areas, a washing station, an office and meeting room, and exhibit areas. The first project to be featured in the rotating exhibit space is the archaeology of the Bennington Bypass project. The goal is to feature different projects in this space over time by utilizing existing and future collections to expose visitors to the many facets of archaeology in Vermont. The Center also serves as the meeting place for the Local Educators meetings that we have been actively involved in to find ways to incorporate archaeology into school curriculums. One collection has already been used many times in schools to help introduce archaeology to students and illustrate how the cultural material is important to interpreting the story of people who lived here.

Presentations Given:

The VTrans Archaeology Officer gave a Poster presentation at TRB Annual Meeting in Washington D.C. of the innovative cultural resource protection methods used on the Lake Champlain Bridge Project. It was extremely popular and garnered the interest of various folks from FHWA and the ACHP. Brennan delivered a presentation on emerging technology in the field of Section 106 review at a recent Vermont Archaeological Society meeting. The talk was well attended and Brennan fielded questions regarding current and upcoming VTrans archaeology projects.

Awards Presented:

VTrans was awarded the Environmental Excellence Award in 2013 by the Federal Highway Administration for Excellence in Cultural and Historical Resources for the Lake Champlain Bridge Project: Preserving Cultural Heritage.

The award highlighted the success of preserving the bridge's legacy as a local landmark and innovative approaches that were used to preserve the archaeological sites. In addition we were recognized for our public outreach efforts and commemoration activities.

Training Provided and Taken:

NIMS ICS training: All VTrans staff were required to complete the first level of the Incident Command System training in light of TS Irene. This training will enable staff to have at least the minimum level of ICS awareness and be better prepared for future events.

ArcGIS: Brennan has been providing ongoing ArcGIS Online support to VTrans, DHP and recently ANR representatives.

Section Goals for 2014

We have already begun working on our Stone Culvert Inventory and are drafting a Consultant RFP. The VTrans Archaeology Staff are continuing to look for training opportunities on digital survey


techniques including LiDAR, and digital mapping programs that can be used on the iPads to collect and record archaeological resource data.

We plan to incorporate 3D scanning along with current standard documentation measures when archaeological features and below ground historic structural elements are encountered. We are currently pursuing this with the UVM Engineering Department as a test case.

We are investigating innovative mitigation measures and public outreach with other State DOT's and SHPO's. Social Media and web-based archaeological outreach are being utilized with success in other states.




