Describe how the grant funds will be spent and attach a project budget:

The Town of Corinth manages over 70 miles of Class II and III roads and has never conducted a town-wide road inventory. A town-wide inventory of road erosion risk locations will be conducted on the 70 miles of town roads by TRORC staff with the VT ANR Road Erosion Risk data layer. From this data and an established evaluation criterion, a prioritized list of town roads and/or structures in need of repair or maintenance will be developed. The top five locations will also be accompanied by a How do you plan to meet the required 20% match on this grant?:

\$928.25 of the \$1,240 match will be in kind Road Foreman labor and road mileage using the Town Truck. The remaining \$312 will be covered by through the Town Highway Fund.

Requested Grant Amount (\$8,000 max): \$ 5,500.00
