TH 9 (Lincoln Lane) Bridge 27

Project Location: Town of Sandgate in Bennington County on Town Highway 9, Lincoln Lane over Terry Brook. The bridge is located approximately 0.6 miles from the junction of Town Highway 9 and Town Highway 2.

The project will replace the existing bridge, which is in poor condition, with a new bridge on the same alignment. The existing bridge is a single span, one lane structure which was constructed in 1960. The bridge is 24 feet in length and is 14 feet wide rail to rail. The bridge deck is in good condition due to the timber decking having been recently replaced. The support girders and substructures are in poor condition and the existing bridge railing is not structurally adequate for modern design standards.

The new bridge will be constructed using precast bridge elements and rapid construction techniques and be lengthened to provide more hydraulic capacity for larger storm events.

The bridge will be constructed on the same alignment while utilizing a short duration road closure.


