

REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF EXISTING PAYPHONE

****From Richmond STP 0284(17) Richmond CMG PARK(31)**

xx. DESCRIPTION. This work shall consist of removing an existing payphone at the location indicated in the Plans and as directed by the Engineer.

xx. CONSTRUCTION REQUIREMENTS. The Contractor shall remove and salvage or dispose of the existing payphone assembly, including the payphone booth/stand and associated components. Existing conduit and wiring shall be abandoned in place, unless otherwise determined by the Engineer or Telephone Company. The Contactor shall relocate any existing conduit and wiring found to be in conflict with proposed improvements and required to be maintained by the Telephone Company as directed by the Engineer at no additional cost to the State.

Salvaging of existing payphone assembly components shall be performed in accordance with the Contract Documents. Components to be salvaged that are damaged or lost by the Contractor during removal shall be repaired or replaced to the satisfaction of VTrans and at the Contractor's expense.

Excavated areas shall be backfilled with material acceptable to the Engineer.

xx. METHOD OF MEASUREMENT. The quantity of Special Provision (Removal and Disposal of Existing Payphone) to be measured for payment will be the number of each payphone assembly removed in the complete and accepted work.

xx. BASIS OF PAYMENT. The accepted quantity of Special Provision (Removal and Disposal of Existing Payphone) at the location specified will be paid for at the Contract unit price per each. Payment will be full compensation for removing and handling the existing payphone assmebly components as specified in the Contract Documents; performing any required excavation and backfilling; and for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals necessary to complete the work.
