

GLARE SCREEN

****From Waterbury IM 089-2(43)(Re-advertised)**

- xx. DESCRIPTION. This work shall consist of furnishing and installing glare screen as depicted on the Plans and as directed by the Engineer.
- xx. GENERAL. The purpose of glare screen is to provide a safer passage of vehicles through the work zone by decreasing the glare from opposing traffic headlights as well as limiting the view of construction activities that distract drivers and hamper traffic flow.
- xx. DESIGN REQUIREMENTS. Glare screen shall be designed to withstand wind loading as well as wind buffeting stresses caused by traffic movement.
- xx. SUBMITTALS. The Contractor shall submit Fabrication Drawings in accordance with Section 105 to the Engineer for review and approval.
- xx. INSTALLATION. Glare screen shall be securely fastened and easily removed from guardrail, bridge railing, or concrete barrier such that the glare screen can be re-used for each phase of construction throughout the entire project duration.
- xx. METHOD OF MEASUREMENT. The quantity of Special Provision (Glare Screen) to be measured for payment will be the number of meters (linear feet) installed in the complete and accepted work.
- xx. BASIS OF PAYMENT. The accepted quantity of Special Provision (Glare Screen) will be paid for at the Contract unit price per meter (linear foot). Payment will be full compensation for designing, detailing, furnishing, installing, relocating, maintaining, monitoring, and removing the materials specified; for making required submittals; and for furnishing all labor, tools, equipment, and incidentals necessary to complete the work.
