### Advanced Certification List (ACL)

The Advanced Certification List (ACL) is a list of products compiled by the Agency that have been approved for use based on an annual certification submitted by the manufacturer; only materials that require a Type A or B Certification per the Agency's Standard Specifications for Construction can be included on the ACL.

Manufacturers are solicited by the Agency annually in December to place one or more of their products on the list by submitting the annual certification form. At the Agency's discretion, the products are added to the list for the next calendar year.

The ACL is a convenience list; it offers a method for fulfilling the certification requirements for materials without having to send the Agency project-specific certifications for the material. However, inclusion on the ACL does not dictate the product must be used. If a product is not included on this list, it may still be used but must have a project-specific certification submitted to the Agency.

The Agency reserves the right to accept submissions to the ACL throughout the year, in the case that this occurs an amended ACL will be published. The Agency reserves the right to exclude a product from the ACL if the annual certification submission is erroneous or does not meet our specifications.

The Agency reserves the right to eliminate a product from the ACL and put back on a project-by-project basis if the products quality is called into question.

To document the use of a product off the ACL the assigned Resident Engineer must complete a TA555 ACL form and submit it to the Certification Unit.
