Dear Chris:

VTrans has completed its review of the revised Contractor Erosion Prevention and Sediment Control (EPSC) Plan, prepared and stamped by George (Joey) Wilson, P.E. and submitted on April 26, 2016. The Plan is **accepted** at this time with the following conditions.

In accordance with the Title 19 Consultation, a pre-construction conference with the ANR River Management Engineer, Josh Carvajal, shall occur prior to any in-stream work, the dates for which are restricted to July 1st thru October 1st. Should you wish to work outside of those dates, written authorization is required.

The project includes a Category II Army Corps of Engineers (COE) Permit. In accordance with this permit, you must submit the Work Start Notification to the COE prior to starting jurisdictional work, with copies sent to the Resident Engineer and Construction Environmental Engineer.

In the event that project changes become necessary in the field, you are required to coordinate with the appropriate regulators and provide copies of such correspondence to the Resident Engineer and Construction Environmental Engineer.

Also, should the need for dewatering arise, the means and methods for doing so will need to be detailed out and reviewed by the Construction Environmental Engineer prior to implementation.

It is the expectation of the Agency that the bridge demolition will meet the requirements of the pay item 529.15 Removal of Structure, including preventing debris from falling into the river. If you choose to saw cut the concrete there must be appropriate containment of the concrete dust/slurry so as to prevent discharge into the Clarendon River.

Finally, any proposed work that is outside the demarcation limits as shown in the contract shall not occur until appropriate clearance is acquired per specification 105.25-105.28.
