Dear Chad:

VTrans has completed its review of the Contractor Erosion Prevention and Sediment Control (EPSC) Plan received via email on January 30, 2014. The Plan is considered **acceptable** at this time. Please address the comments below in accordance with the permit conditions prior to disturbing any earth.

The Stream Alterations Permit #HD-4-1016 has in-water working dates of July 1- October 1. The schedule submitted with the Plan indicates that there will be work in the stream below the ordinary high water elevation of 882.5' outside of the in-water work dates. This would appear to include the Abutment #1 & #2 excavation work as well as the stone fill work. Provide written verification that work outside these dates will be allowed.

The Construction General Permit #6942-9020 requires that the Contractor become a co-permittee. This form must be filed with the DEC Stormwater Office prior to starting work. Copy the Resident Engineer when then has been done.

The Corps of Engineers Permit #NAE-2013-0027 requires that you file the Work Start Notification form provided in the Contract documents. Copy the Resident Engineer when then has been done.

The staging area at the Clear River Inn for the Engineers Trailer must still have an Exemption Form filled out and filed with the Resident Engineer.
