Dear Charlie:

VTrans has completed its review of the Contractor Erosion Prevention and Sediment Control (EPSC) Plan submitted on October 22, 2015. The Plan is considered acceptable at this time with the following conditions.

The garage staging area specified in your proposed narrative must be submitted and approved per specification 105.25- 105.28 before using the site.

The Title 19 Stream Alterations Consultation Letter stipulates that you must meet with the VT DEC River Management Engineer prior to commencement of in-stream work. Has this occurred? Please provide written documentation from the River Management Engineer indicating that your approach and schedule is considered acceptable to them.

The Corps of Engineers CAT II permit requires that the Work Start Notification form be filed 2 weeks prior to the start of work (in contract documents). Has this form been filed? Please ensure to copy the Resident Engineer and myself, so we have it on record. The only authorized work below Ordinary High Water is associated with the permanent rip rap work. If you need to go outside the

limits shown in the Corps Permit you must coordinate with the Corps prior to performing that work.

Please remember that any other proposed work or staging that is outside the demarcation limits as shown in the contract shall not occur until appropriate clearance is acquired per specification 105.25-105.28.
