**RE: ROCHESTER BRF 0162(16) AND BRF 0162(17) CONTRACTOR EROSION  
PREVENTION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL PLAN**

Dear Kevin:

VTrans has completed its review of the Contractor Erosion Prevention and Sediment Control (EPSC) Plan labeled *BR 15 EPSC phase 1* and *BR 16 EPSC phase 1* both dated June 4<sup>th</sup>, 2014 and located the Contractor SharePoint Site. The Plans are considered **acceptable** at this time for Phase 1 only to establish your work sites.

One concern I have is working next to/in the brook. If you plan to be doing work in the brook prior to July 1 you must seek approval by the ANR River Management Engineer, Pat Ross. This must be in writing. I didn't see any documentation allowing work prior July 1. In addition you are showing your limits of work for staging at the edge of the brook at both sites. If it is at all possible it would be preferable to leave a buffer of vegetation between your work and the brook.

It is the expectation of the Agency that a proactive approach is taken to prevent erosion and control sediment. As part of that expectation it will be necessary to plan ahead and coordinate with the Engineer prior to implementing preventative measures.
