Eligibility for fuel assistance benefits is based on a household's gross income. A fuel household is not eligible for seasonal fuel benefits if the household's gross income exceeds 185% of the federal poverty guidelines.

The Fuel and Utility Programs Team must update these guidelines every year based on federal poverty guidelines. (Seasonal Fuel Assistance Rule 2913)
