Homelessness Prevention

Homelessness Prevention may be used to prevent an individual or family that is experiencing a housing crisis from becoming homeless (including avoiding moving into emergency shelter, the streets, a publicly funded motel, or a place not meant for human habitation) or to help an individual or family regain stability in current housing or other permanent housing.

Homelessness Prevention Activities

- 1. **Housing Navigation Services** to provide logistical and housing support to households preparing to move into permanent housing. *See Case Management Service Definitions in Section 1 for more information*.
- 2. **Housing Retention Services** to provide ongoing, individualized support and coordination for households once stabilized in permanent housing. *See Case Management Service Definitions in Section 1 for more information.*
