Child Care Financial Assistance Program

Accepted Service Needs

Each primary caretaker in your household must have at least one of the following reasons to need child care:

- Has a job
- Is self-employed
- Is actively looking for work
- Is attending school or training
- Is participating in Reach Up activities
- Has special health needs and is unable to provide care for the child

OR

- The child receiving services has significant health or specialized developmental needs.
- The child receiving services has an open case with DCF's Family Services Division and child care is part of the safety plan.

OR

 The family is experiencing significant stress in areas such as shelter, safety, emotional stability, substance abuse, children's behaviors, and parenting issues.
