Services are:

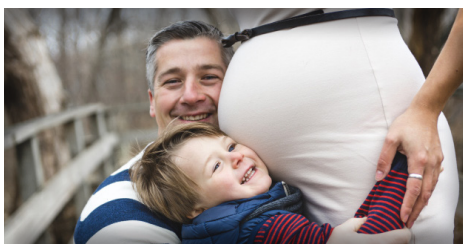
- Available anywhere in the state at low or no cost to families.
