

### **CDD Course Criteria to meet Child Care Licensing Requirements:**

- **Child or Human Development (CD) (CBCCPP rules in 7.3.2)**
  - Successfully complete one 3 college credit course that includes:
    - Theories and research on child development,
    - Various influences on development and their potential impacts
    - Stages of development, and
    - Arenas of development that include cognitive, motor, language, and social-emotional.
- **Curriculum (CU) (CBCCPP rule 7.3.1.3)**
  - Successfully complete one 3 college credit course that covers elements related to instruction and development of curricula for early or elementary education and focuses on one or more of the following:
    - How we teach which must include developmentally appropriate practices, lesson planning, and scaffolding learning; and/or
    - Inclusion of children with diverse abilities and addressing individual needs and/or
    - Content specific subject areas such as math, science, language and literacy, music, and art.
- **Program Management (PM) (CBCCPP rules 7.3.1.3 and 7.3.1.4)**
  - Successfully complete one 3 college credit course that includes:
    - Managing program operations,
    - Legal and financial considerations,
    - Personnel and resource management, and
    - Working with clients.
- **Staff Supervision (SS) (CBCCPP rule 7.3.1.3 and 7.3.1.4)**
  - Successfully complete one 3 college credit course that includes:
    - Styles of supervision, and
    - Hiring and evaluating staff.
- **Administration (AD) (CBCCPP rule 7.3.1.4)**
  - Successfully complete one 3 college credit course that includes:
    - Establishing and administering policies and program operations,
    - Program leadership,
    - Personnel and resource management, and
    - Working with clients
  - A college course or combination of courses that combined meet the Management course required in 7.3.1.5 will also be accepted to meet the AD course requirement in 7.3.1.4
- **Human Resource Management (HR) (CBCCPP rule 7.3.1.4)**
  - Successfully complete one 3 college credit course that focuses on human resource management.
