

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
Chittenden County Homeless Alliance

- CCHA is a HUD recognized Continuum of Care
 - A COC is a local planning body that coordinates HUD funding and housing resources for those experiencing homelessness in that community.
 - COCs can encompass a city, a county, or multiple neighboring counties.
- Geographic area is Chittenden County
 - Outside Chittenden is a seperate CoC, Balance of State (HHAV).
- The CCHA oversees the Chittenden County Coordinated Entry System (CE)
 - All CE policies and procedures are set by CCHA.
 - The committees that work in CE are subcommittees of the CCHA.



CCHA Coordinated Entry Committee

- The Coordinated Entry Committee is a subcommittee of the CCHA and is mainly responsible for overseeing Chittenden Coordinated Entry.
 - Updates and improvements to Coordinated Entry Policies and Procedures.
 - Participating in the Coordinated Entry Evaluation Process.
 - Approving the Coordinated Entry Partnership Agreement.
 - Assist in creating and approving MOUs with housing partners.
 - System improvement projects.
 - Anything else relevant to the running of Chittenden Coordinated Entry.



Community Housing Review Committee (CHRC):

- CHRC is a weekly meeting for housing navigation staff in Chittenden County:
 - O It is a subcommittee of the CCHA Coordinated Entry Committee.
 - Unlike all other CCHA subcommittees, it is a confidential meeting as it deals directly with client information.
 - All referrals to Chittenden Coordinated Entry housing resources go through CHRC.
 - Includes housing opportunities, retention services, and subsidies.
 - Coordinated Entry trainings happen during this meeting.
 - Updates on any policy changes for CE that affect housing navigators
