



Perform Examinations for Social Security Disability

- Provide examination and test findings to the decision-makers at Vermont Disability Determination Services (VT DDS). CE providers are not responsible for disability ratings or treatment plans.
- Decide how many examinations to provide on a schedule that fits *your* needs. Current CE providers perform a range from 1 to 30 exams a month depending on their capacity and schedule.
- Perform exams and submit reports of findings in accordance with Social Security Administration guidelines provided by the DDS.
- Receive prompt payment from the State of Vermont, based on a federally approved fee schedule, similar to Medicare rates. No private health insurance or Medicaid billing or payment is involved!
