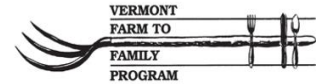

Hello Farmer Market Manager,

We would like to welcome you to the 2026 Farm to Family Season.

We are excited to get this season off to a great start, and it all starts with you. Enclosed in this packet, you will find all the necessary forms and documents to get your market enrolled as an authorized market for this season.

You must complete the following by May 1, 2026:

- Read and Keep the Rules and Procedures.
- Complete the online Market Manager Training at <https://dcf.vermont.gov/esd/partners/f2f>.
- Read, Complete, and Return:
 - Market Agreement
 - Federal Taxpayer Identification Number Assurance Form
 - W-9
 - Market Information Form

When the completed Market Agreement, Taxpayer Assurance Form, W-9, and Market Information form are returned to the Farm to Family program, we will mail you an Authorized Market packet. That packet will include all the necessary information for you to enroll farmers to be authorized vendors, redeem coupons and be a successful participating Farm to Family Farmers Market. **Please note you are not authorized to enroll vendors or accept coupons until you receive the Authorized market packet sent in June.** If you are a new Market Manager for the Farm to Family program, you will be contacted to complete an interactive training.

You must return the required forms by May 1, 2026. We will be unable to enroll markets after this deadline.
