P-2210G Out of School Youth (Reach Up Services rule 2320) (23-12)

Inform District Management team if 16 or 17 year old child in the Reach Up household is no longer a full time student, or if a household applies and there is an eligible child in the home that is 16 or 17 years old and is not in school full time.

Out of school youth (previously known as Mandatory Youth) may be able to work with a Reach Up case manager. It is up to the youth if they want to engage with the case manager.

The following STAT edit will appear when a 16 or 17 year old is included in the Reach Up household, but is not attending school and is not listed on the SCHL panel.
