

## General Assistance Emergency Housing April 1<sup>st</sup> 2023 – June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2023

On March 20<sup>th</sup>, the Budget Adjustment Act of 2023 (“BAA”) was enacted. The BAA provides funding for households categorically eligible for Emergency Housing, as outlined below. Additionally, the BAA provides continued funding for eligibility under the Adverse Weather Conditions Policy, regardless of temperature, through May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023.

1. The following categorical eligibility is effective from **4/1/23 to 6/30/23**. Households that meet one of the following eligibility categories must have income at or below 185% of the Federal Poverty Level and may not have resources in excess of \$2250. There is no limit on the number of nights a household may be eligible for.
  - A household with a member aged 60 or older,
  - A household with a member with receiving SSI or SSDI,
  - A household with a school aged child,
  - A household with a member who is pregnant,
  - A household with a member who has been evicted or left a rental situation due to a health code violation,
  - A household with a member who is a victim of domestic violence,
  - A household with a member who is a victim of a fire, flood, or natural disaster.
  
2. Households that are not eligible under one of the above categories may be eligible under the Adverse Weather Conditions Policy through **5/31/23**. There are no income or resource limits for households eligible under Adverse Weather Conditions.
