Title 33, §5320 and §5321 (Post-disposition & permanency review)

- ⇒ You have the right to be heard. The judge may ask you to do this either verbally or in writing.
- ⇒ You may be asked to leave the hearing once you've been heard. It's up to the judge.
- To make a request, bring this card to court and see the court clerk. The clerk will bring your request to the judge's attention.
