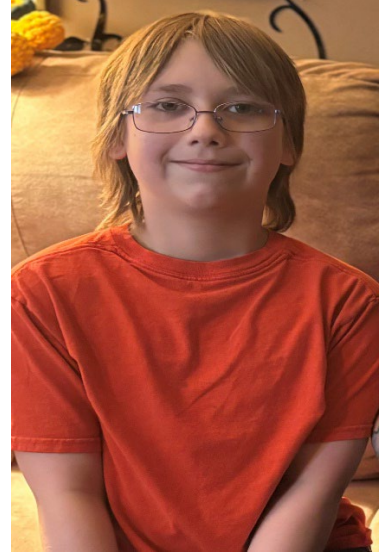




Meet Gyles
