## **Their Relationship and Family Needs**

The girls would benefit from a home that can provide structure, routine, and individualized attention. Ideally, each child would have her own bedroom or dedicated personal space where she can relax and recharge. Caregivers should be prepared to support both girls in developing healthy communication, conflict-resolution skills, and positive sibling interactions.

Both girls respond well to clear expectations, consistent routines, and caregivers who take the time to explain why certain behaviors are not acceptable. They benefit from calm, trauma-informed parenting approaches that balance accountability with understanding and support.

## **Support Services**

Jennifer and Chloe have access to school-based and in-home service providers who can assist caregivers in understanding and meeting their needs. They are also enrolled in a daily summer camp program, which may be available as a resource for future caregivers.
