

APPENDIX D. RENTAL UNIT SIZE

The Champlain Valley Office of Economic Opportunity is responsible for determining the rental unit size for the CARES Housing Voucher Project. Rental unit size is determined based on household size. The following chart shows the rental unit size by the number of persons in the household:

Rental Unit Size	Persons in Household
1 Bedroom	1-2
2 Bedrooms	2-4
3 Bedrooms	3-6
4 Bedrooms	4-8
5 Bedrooms	6-10

The client will be allowed one bedroom for each two persons within the household, except in the following circumstances:

- Persons of different generations and unrelated adults will be allocated a separate bedroom.
- Live-in aides will be allocated a separate bedroom.
- Children in the custody of the Department for Children and Families not currently living with the family, but likely to be reunified within 180 days will be included in the household for the purposes of determining rental unit size

The limitations above should not create onerous barriers for households to identify appropriate housing. If housing opportunities or needs arise that do not fit within these constraints, please request a waiver by contacting [Sandrine Kibuey](#).
