INCARCERATION UNDER MORE THAN ONE RULE

REFERENCE SHEET

Look to the offenses of the CONTROLLING SENTENCE:

1. Pre-94 rules apply if at least one offense from the controlling sentence was committed on or before June 30, 1994.
2. 1994 rules apply if at least one offense from the controlling sentence was committed during the period July 1, 1994 through June 30, 2000, and no offense was committed prior to July 1, 1994.
3. 2000 rules apply if at least one offense from the controlling sentence was committed during the period July 1, 2000 through June 15, 2001, and no offense was committed prior to July 1, 2000.
4. 2001 rules apply if at least one offense from the controlling sentence was committed on or after June 16, 2001 through June 30, 2005, and no offense was committed prior to June 16, 2001.
5. 2005 rules apply only if all offense(s) were committed on or after July 1, 2005.

Exception to above: If inmate has committed a new offense and the prior minimum sentence has been satisfied, the new minimum release date shall be calculated using the rules the new offense was committed under. A controlling sentence can have different rules on the minimum and maximum.
