The purpose of this Rescinding Memo is to rescind the following thirteen (13) Vermont Department of Corrections’ (DOC) superseded and outdated mental health directives:

1. #305 *Coordination with Vermont State Hospital* (Effective 09/23/74)
  - This document is outdated. Mental health services for inmates are governed by law and administered by the DOC’s healthcare contractor.
2. #361 *Mental Health Services* (Effective 08/31/82)
  - This document is outdated. The DOC now contracts for mental health services.
3. #361.01 *Mental Health Directive* (Effective 08/27/97)
  - This document is outdated. Mental health services for inmates are governed by law and administered by the DOC’s healthcare contractor.
4. #361.01.01 *Mental Health Receiving Screening* (Effective 08/20/97)
  - This document is outdated and has been superseded by the DOC’s Interim Memo, *Suicide Prevention and Response to Self-Harm* (Effective 05/01/2019).
5. #361.01.04 *Mental Health Evaluation* (Effective 08/20/97)
  - This document is outdated. The DOC now contracts for mental health services.
6. #361.01.05 *Mental Health Services* (Effective 08/20/97)
  - This document is outdated. Mental health services for inmates are governed by law and administered by the DOC’s healthcare contractor.
7. #361.01.06 *Individualized Treatment Planning* (Effective 08/20/97)
  - This document is outdated. The DOC now contracts for mental health services.

8. #361.01.09 *Residential Treatment Programs* (Effective 08/20/97)
  - This document is outdated. The DOC no longer operates residential treatment programs. Programs provided to inmates within correctional facilities are facilitated through the DOC's healthcare contractor.
9. #361.01.10 *Mental Health Rounds in Segregation Units* (Effective 08/20/97)
  - This document is outdated and has been superseded by the DOC's Policy #370/APA Rule 05-049, *Classification, Treatment and the Use of Administrative and Disciplinary Segregation for Inmates with a Serious Mental Illness* (Effective 12/21/05).
10. #361.01.12 *Mental Health Roster/Admission/Discharge Criteria* (Effective 08/20/97)
  - This document is outdated. The DOC now contracts for mental health services.
11. #361.01.14 *Psychotropic Medications* (Effective 08/20/97)
  - This document is outdated. The provision of prescription medication is governed by law and administered by the DOC's healthcare contractor.
12. #363 *Alcohol and Drug Abuse Treatment Services* (Effective 05/30/83)
  - This document is outdated. The DOC now contracts for healthcare services, including the provision of substance abuse services.
13. #364 *AA-Recovery Program in Correctional Facilities* (Effective 05/23/86)
  - This document is outdated. The DOC provides AA and other programs through volunteers, which is covered in the DOC's Directive #376, *Volunteer Services and Management* (Effective 12/08/15).

These directives shall be rescinded effective immediately.
