On January 15, 2021, you filed a request with the Vermont Department of Public Service (the "Department") for access under the Vermont Public Records Act (1 V.S.A. §§ 315 et. seq., the "Act") to certain documents. In your request, you set forth the following:

Matt Dunne claims today in Senate Finance that he knows mobile hot spots will work in 90% of Vermont and in most cases, sometimes using signal boosters, and will reach 90% of unserved addresses with adequate service.

- 1. Please provide both maps where available as pdfs and as propagation data in shapefile format, all the data supporting that plan and conclusions.**
- 2. Please also provide any data supporting 4G cell network congestion analysis of same.**
- 3. Please also provide any records detailing the Department's response and action steps in response to the CTC/RISI recommendations [sic].**
