13 V.S.A. §2901 – Punishment for perjury: "A person who, being lawfully required to depose the truth in a proceeding in a court of justice, commits perjury shall be imprisoned not more than fifteen years and fined not more than \$10,000.00, or both."

17 V.S.A. §2122(b) – "A person may have his or her name on the checklist **only in the town of which the person is a resident**. For the purpose of this chapter, "resident" shall mean **a person who is domiciled in the town as evidenced by an intent to maintain a principal dwelling place in the town indefinitely and to return there if temporarily absent, coupled with an act or acts consistent with that intent**. If a person removes to another town with the intention of remaining there indefinitely, that person shall be considered to have lost residence in the town in which the person originally resided even though the person intends to returnat some future time. However, a person shall retain the ability to vote in a town of former residence for a periodof 17 days after becoming a resident of a new town. A person may have only one residence at a given time."
