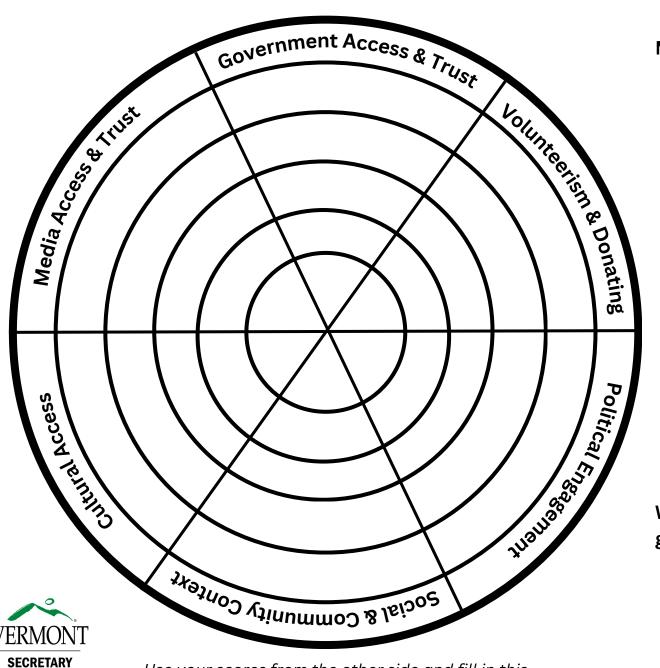

- How often do you participate in cultural experiences such as exploring new music, attending performances, or reading a book not required for school?

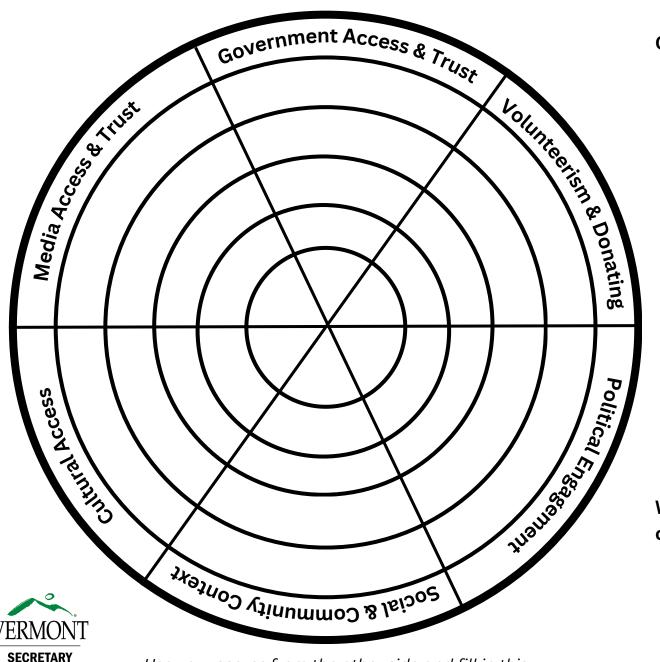
#### **Media Trust & Access**
